The Board agreed that this could help out our upcoming club shows and would agree to have this in place. President Rick Demers talked about the 5 x 6 ft. trailer which would store the clubs equipment for the coin shows. Once he gets the trailer he will use a tarp donated by Linton Duet Jr. to protect the outside of the trailer.

President Rick Demers asked for Recording Secretary Linton Duet Jr. to provide him with an updated list of club Member's telephone numbers if this could be done. Recording Secretary Linton Duet Jr. advised that he will try to get as many numbers as possible for the updated list.

The Board discussed about reducing the hall at the Double Tree Hotel to have 2/3 the size instead of the whole area. This would have savings of about \$800.00 per show event. President Rick Demers called for a motion, motion by Bruce Ehrman and seconded by Linton Duet Jr. to have Immediate Past President Bob Eddy III look into getting this done if possible with the Double Tree Hotel, motion carried 7 votes for and 0 no votes.

There was a discussion about the Stamp Club participating at the 2013 coin shows. President Rick Demers will talk with the club President about this matter.

NEW BUSINESS

Recording Secretary Linton Duet Jr. mentioned that he felt that the membership booth should be placed at the

front door at upcoming coins show events. He advised that the present spot inside the coin show arena does not carry the attention to coin collectors to join the club, whereas at the front door a club member could get the attention of a collector once that person comes to enter the coin arena. The Board decided that this was a good idea and will conduct this endeavor the next coin show.

President Rick Demers mentioned to the Board that the meals at the regular Membership Meetings would be cancelled due to not enough meals being sold.

There was a motion by Treasurer Mike Buras and seconded by Bruce Ehrman to adjourn the Board Meeting all were in favor motion passes. Meeting adjourned at 8:40 pm.
