Rick Demers had a show & tell of a blank planchet that looks like a U S Quarter. He passed it around for people to look at & say decide what they think it is. Many people gave their opinions on the planchet. It is a foreign planchet, but no one knows for what. The reasons it is not a U S Quarter are: slightly larger, has a reeded edge (the U S coins but the reeded edge on at the time of pressing the design), and it is not clad.
